

## Meeting Minutes

September 14, 2015

The regular quarterly meeting of St. John Vianney CCW was held September 14, 2015 at 7:00 pm in the hospitality room of SJV Church. This was the transition from Carol Paterson's leadership to the following Executive Board: Co-chairs are Beth Kloeckner and Diane Pearson First Vice-chair, Mitzi Lockwood; Secretary, Elizabeth Garry; Treasurer, Loreen Maurice; Communications, Diana Scott; and Funerals, Mary Murphy.

Beth read a letter from Ron Stauter, the head of CREST, asking for more volunteers. He said the need is growing and the volunteers are decreasing.

Diana Scott is in charge of decorations, and her committee consisting of Cathy Bishop, Mitzi Lockwood, Beth Kloeckner, and LaDona Anderson will set up at 5:00.
