HELP IS NEEDED

We continue to experience problems with our dishwashing crews and need your help. As an example, the last event that we had at our hall that required members to help with dishes had '7' members assigned. The captain contacted his committee members before the event and of the '7' members assigned '2' did not answer their phone or return a call, '1' indicated that he would be out of town and '4' members indicated that they would be available to do dishes. The night of the event came and only '2' members showed up to help. This presented a big problem as 260 guests were in attendance and a total of '3' members, which included the captain, available to help. This lack of available manpower would undoubtedly increase the time to complete the job from between 1.5hrs-2hrs to 3hrs-3.5 hrs. The solution to this problem resulted in the member assigned to do security stepping forward to help, a member and his wife, who were guests at the party, stepping forward to help and another member available to help with the dishwasher. The dishes did get done but at what cost?? It certainly was not fair to the member who was assigned to do security, as he already was volunteering his time and had other responsibilities to take care of. It certainly was not fair to the member and his wife who were out for a relaxing evening, only to feel compelled to help with dishes because other members were not available. I question how anxious the '3' members who were available to help with dishes would be the next time their help was requested, if this job did take 3hrs to 3.5 hours to complete???? PLEASE, if you are assigned to help with dishes do so and if you have a conflict PLEASE find your own substitute (trade with member of another committee) and inform your captain of such. Remember the captain, who is responsible for the committee, is doing so only in support of our council. He, as everyone else, gets paid nothing and needs all of our support in order to complete the task. If you are presently on a dishwashing crew, or have been in the past, and would rather be on another committee (cleanup, setup, etc.) please contact Andy Lucas at 238-1213 and inform him of such. Remember all tasks of our council take a minimal amount of time to complete when all workers get involved!!!! HALL RENTAL COSTS

The cost for a "Full Building Rental" is **\$400 for Friday & Saturday rentals**. This will provide access to the large and small hall areas of our facility, as well as the patio area. The patio area **"WILL NOT"** have tables and chairs set up. The cost for a "Full Building Rental" plus a furnished patio area is \$450 for Friday & Saturday Rentals. This will provide access to the large and small hall areas of our building, as well as the patio area. The patio area **"WILL"** have tables and chairs set up that will seat an additional 100 people (weather permitting). Included in this fee will be the extension of the inside PA system to the patio area. Members of our council will receive a 25% discount off these prices. Anyone interested in renting our facility for **Monday thru Thursday**--the rentals fees are \$1 per person, \$75 minimum for one room up to '4' hours, or \$125 minimum for over 4 hours and up to '8' hours. The cost for two room rentals is \$1 per person, \$150 minimum for up to '4' hours, or \$1 per person \$200 minimum for over 4 hours and up to '8' hours. A '1' hour setup time will be allowed at no charge. Maximum rental fee is \$400. **Sunday Rentals**--Sunday rental fee's will be \$1 per person, \$100 minimum for one room up to 4 hours or \$150 minimum for over 4 hours and up to 8 hours. The cost for a two room rental is \$1 per person \$150 minimum for up to 4 hours or \$250 minimum for over 4 hours and up to 8 hours. The maximum rental fee is \$400. A '1 hour setup time will be allowed at no charge. These are very competitive rates, while also providing a great service for our community. **The maximum weekday/weekend rental cost for a member is \$300** (75% of \$400--please note membership discounts only apply to the \$400 rentals), while the maximum cost for non-members is \$400. Call 238-9340 to make your reservation. Your call will be answered by an answering service, so be prepared to leave a message or you may call our Building Manager, Jack Newville, directly at 848-0529 to schedule your rental. **Please consider mentioning to your family and friends that our facility is available to everyone in the community for rentals.**
